Each course offered at the Community College of Allegheny County has been evaluated, and transferability of each course has been determined.

The University of Pittsburgh will accept a maximum of 60 credits from a community college. All courses transfer as lower level, freshman or sophomore level courses. A grade earned in a class taken at the Community College of Allegheny County will not replace the grade from an equivalent class taken at the University of Pittsburgh.

Students planning to pursue a major offered through any other school at the University of Pittsburgh should consult the “Pitt Connection” for that school’s transfer policies.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The specific structure of a degree at the College of General Studies varies depending upon the major. However, all students must complete certain course requirements. If you should want to take any other courses, verify transferability with your Community College of Allegheny County transfer counselor or a College of General Studies academic advisor. Note: A grade of C or better is required for transfer.
